

Dear Customer / Tenant:

We have been engaged by the Management of the building to carry out a routine pest control service program in the premises occupied by you. This service is being performed to prevent/eliminate **COCKROACH** infestations gel baits.

The service will be performed on _______. It is not necessary to vacate your premises after the service is complete.

In order to enable our Pest Management Professionals to apply an effective treatment, we require your cooperation in carrying out the following instructions:

- 1. Remove **all items** from the kitchen cupboards and drawers. The tops of refrigerators and stoves should be cleared off so they can be moved out.
- 2. Remove all items from your bathroom vanities.
- 3. Shelves and floor perimeters in all closets and linen cupboards must have all items removed. These items can be placed on beds and do not require covering.
 - **NOTE**: Hanging clothes can remain in closets and will not be affected by the treatment.
- 4. Birds and pets do not need to be removed from the premises.
- 5. Furniture in all rooms should be moved at least 2 (two) feet away from the walls and as close to the center of the room as possible. This will allow access to the baseboards for treatment.

The gel bait cockroach treatment:

- Cockroach gel baits have no odor or fumes, is non-combustible, and remains where it is applied.
- Cockroach gel baits are not harmful to people suffering from asthma, allergies or lung disease since there is no spray drift.
- Since Cockroach gel baits attract roaches to it, you may notice more roaches after an application. The roaches become disorientated they may wander after a feeding and soon die.

On returning to your premises, no chemical sprays such as Raid or bleach are to be used by the Tenant after the Cockroach gel bait treatment, as it will contaminate the roach bait.
