



TIPS FOR MOUSE AND RAT TRAPS

Rodents enter a home through holes around the size of a dime and run along walls, not over open spaces. For any trap used to eliminate rats or mice (snap traps, live traps, sticky traps, or bait stations) you can follow the guidelines below:

- Place mouse traps flush with the wall
- Place traps out unset for a few days so rodents can become familiar with it
- Place traps where rodent activity is seen (sign of chewing, droppings, runway, burrow)
- Leave mouse traps undisturbed for at least two days before moving to a new location
- Check mouse traps daily and replace as needed
- Wear gloves when disposing of rodents
